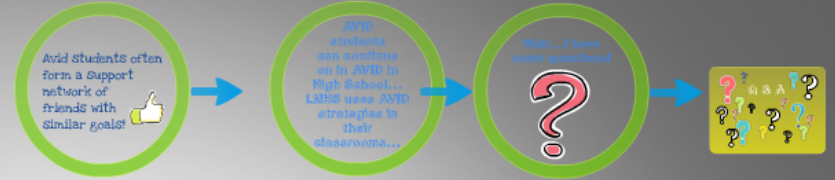


What Will I Need For AVID?

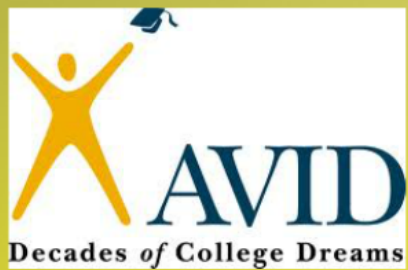
What is AVID?
